Alpha – Why it is Essential

Why is it a better goal to bring a person into an Alpha course than to win a person to Christ? Alpha is Catholic. It is based on the Bible translated from the manuscripts located around Alexandria, Egypt. (See appendix)

A conservative Christian would argue that a person may die before finishing the course and deciding to follow Jesus; thereby subjecting him to an eternity in hell. We have two lines of manuscripts that make up two different translations of the Bible. Paul says that the second gospel includes another Jesus which comes with another spirit (*1 Corinthians 11:3-4*). After going through the Alpha program, you may decide to follow that other Jesus and experience confirmation from the other spirit. You will not even consider that the other translation could be correct. You will now have been indoctrinated and received a spirit that will keep you from likely ever considering the truth of God's Word. You will as Jude explains have become twice dead (*Jude 11-13*).

Secondly, the reason it would be important to take the course first is that the Bible says that when we accept Christ we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. John says that we no longer need man to teach us but that this anointing will teach us (*1 John 2:27*). Jesus says that this Spirit will guide us into all truth (John 16:13). You see if a person accepts Christ first, the Holy Spirit within will create an unsettling that will not allow the person to fully accept the indoctrination being presented. In order to be at peace with what is being taught you will have to reject the anointing you have already received (*Hebrews 6:4-6*).

³But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

⁴For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. (*1 Corinthians 11:3-4*)

¹¹Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core.

¹²These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear:

clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; ¹³Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever. (*Jude 11-13*)

Who are Cain, Balaam and Core? God had instructed man as to what was an acceptable sacrifice. Cain instead chose to offer what he decided was appropriate, but God did not accept it. The Holy Scriptures as found around Antioch were taken to Alexandria, Egypt, changed, and presented as the oldest and most accurate. This is the way of Cain. Balaam was instrumental in enticing the people of Israel to get entangled with other gods. Many ideas have been embraced by the church that have roots in eastern mysticism such as Yoga, Reike and Listening Prayer now renamed Discernment. These are the error of Balaam. Core felt that he was entitled and that Moses was not the only one who spoke for God. Within the church is found the word-faith movement, pantheism, and new revelation that takes preeminence to the Bible. This is the gainsaying of Core.

²⁷But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you:


but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. (*1 John 2:27*)
