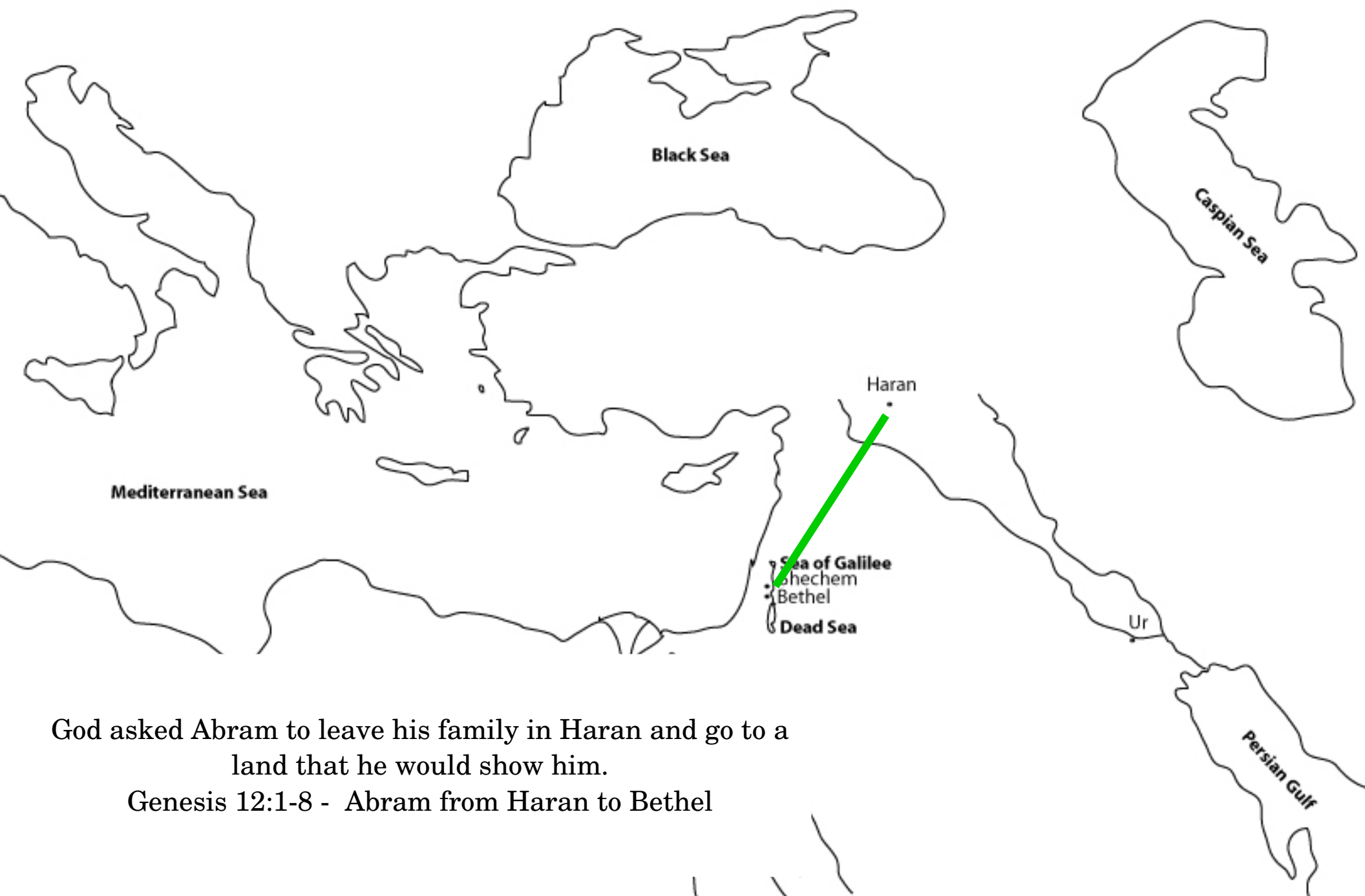


# The Bible Origin





God asked Abram to leave his family in Haran and go to a land that he would show him.

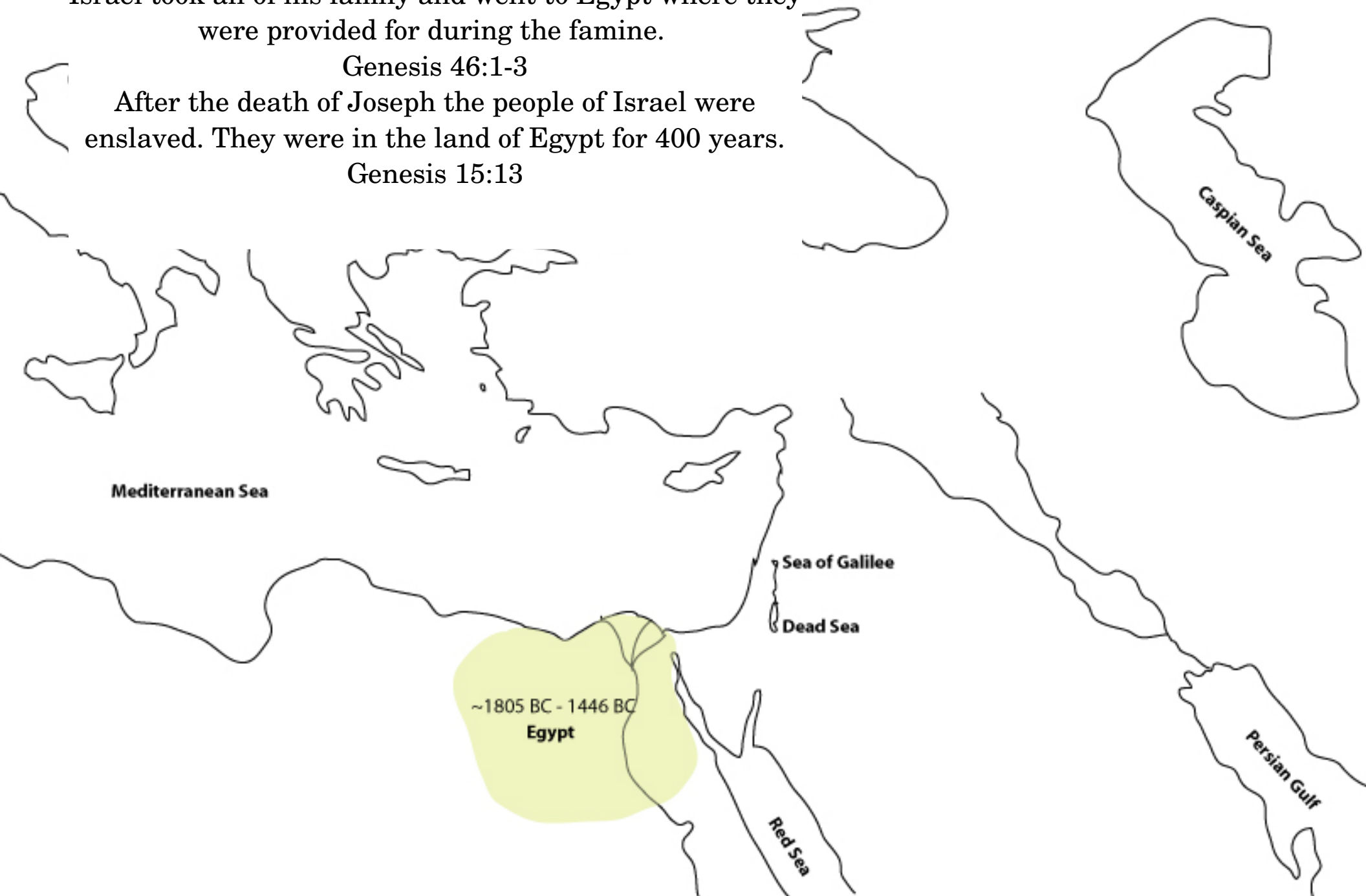
Genesis 12:1-8 - Abram from Haran to Bethel

Genesis 15:13

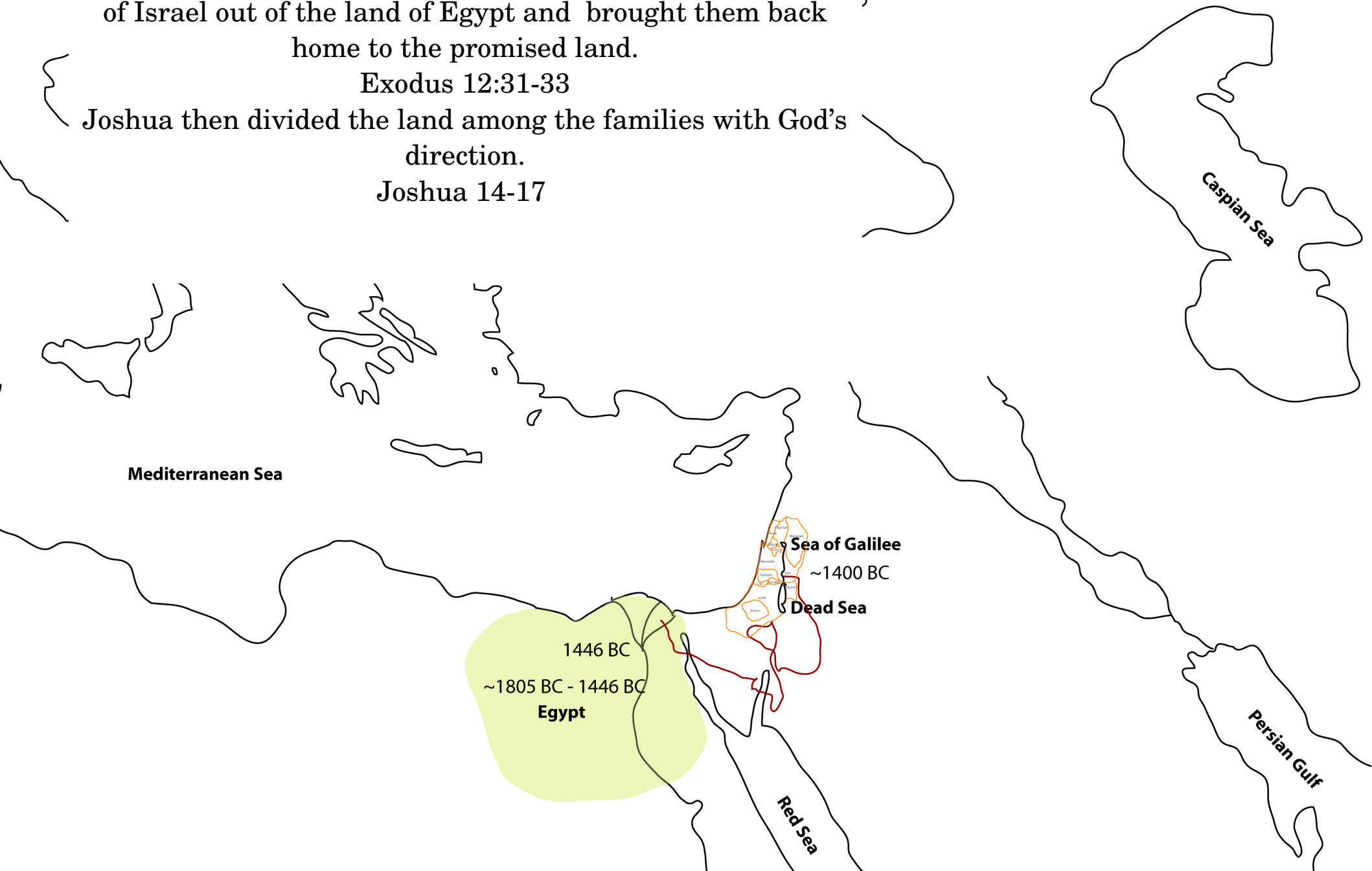


After being in Egypt for 400 years, Moses led all of the people

home to the promised land.

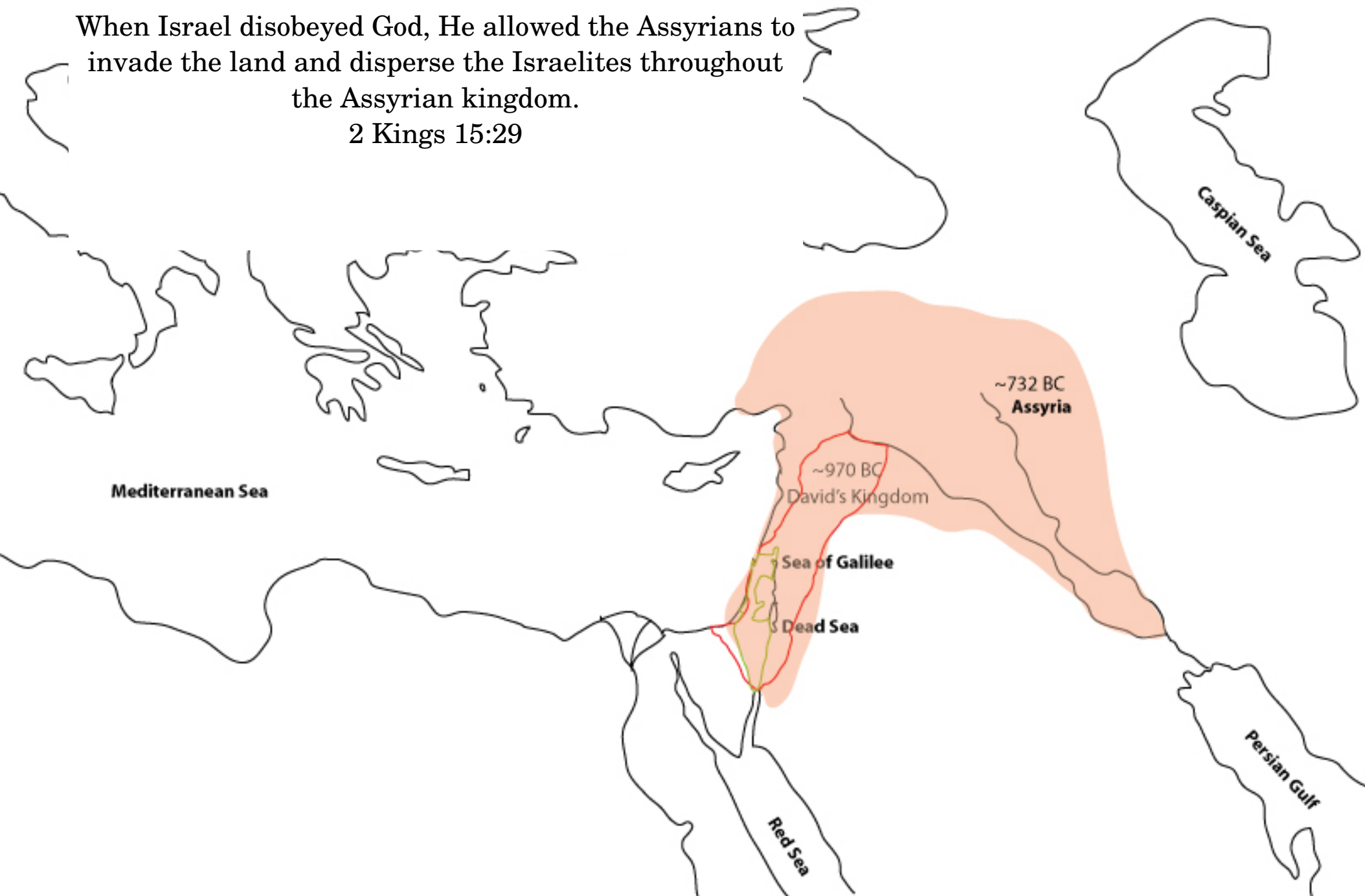
Exodus 12:31-33

Joshua 14-17

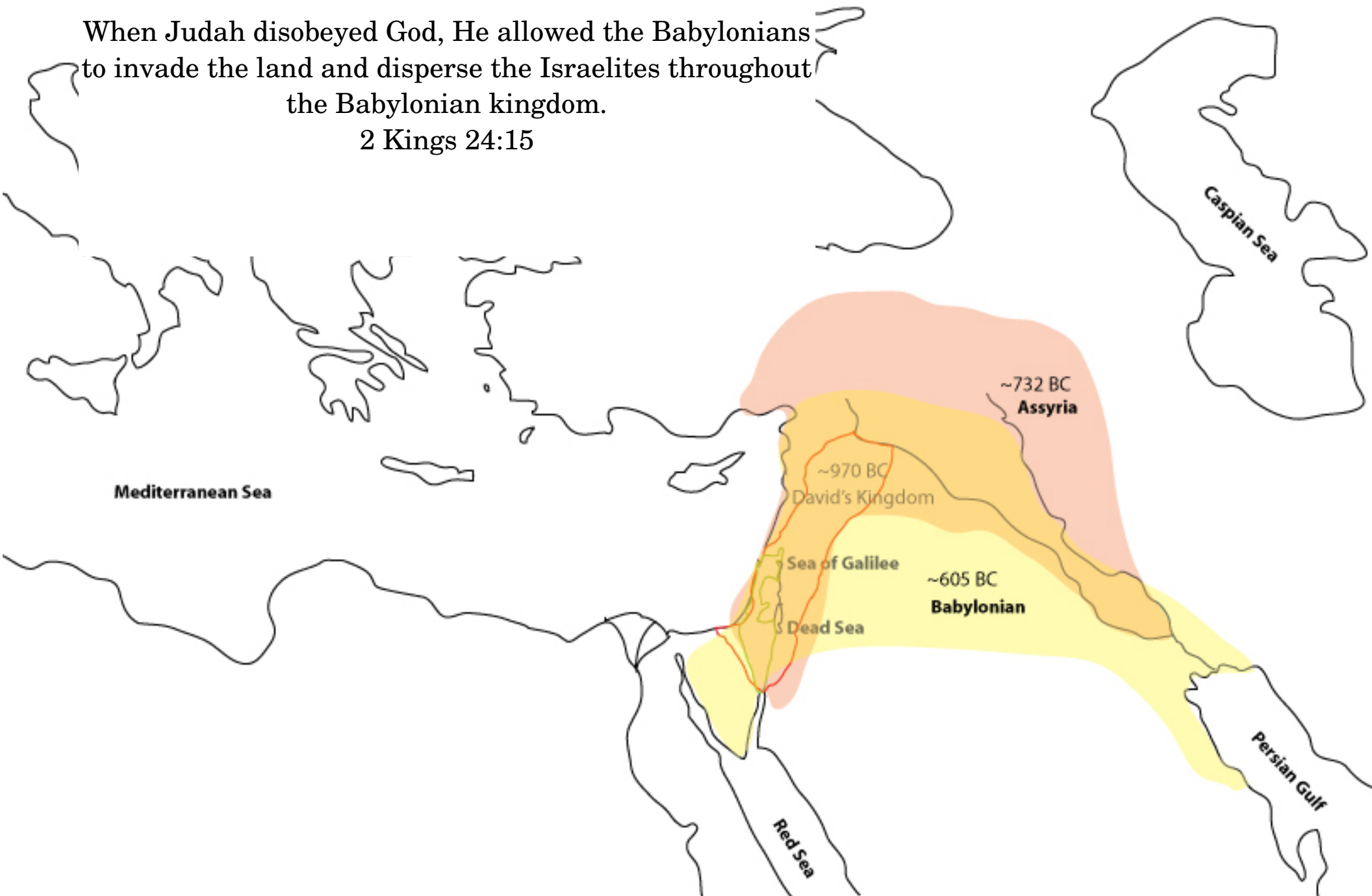


When Israel disobeyed God, He allowed the Assyrians to invade the land and disperse the Israelites throughout the Assyrian kingdom.  
2 Kings 15:29

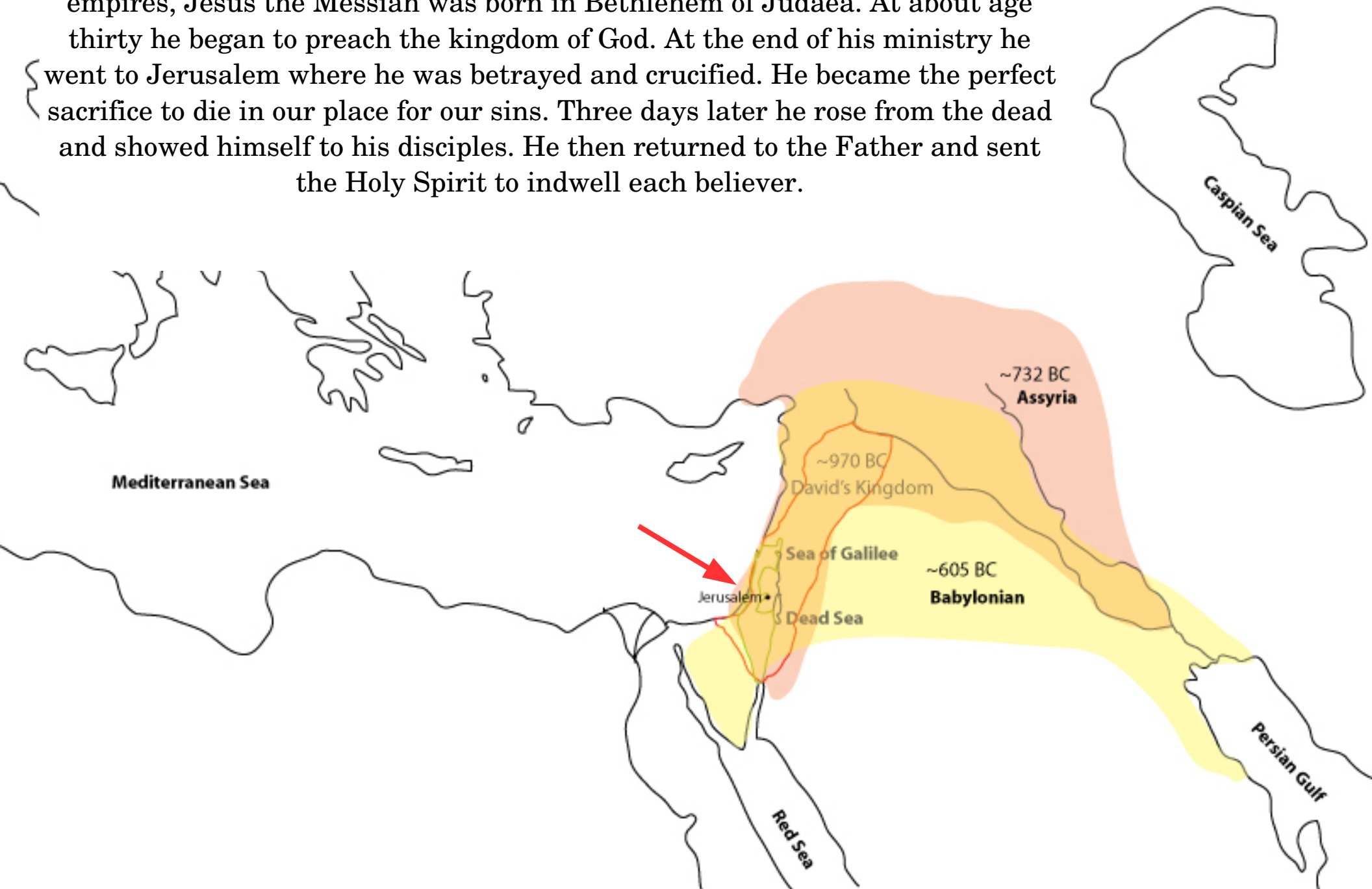


When Judah disobeyed God, He allowed the Babylonians to invade the land and disperse the Israelites throughout the Babylonian kingdom.

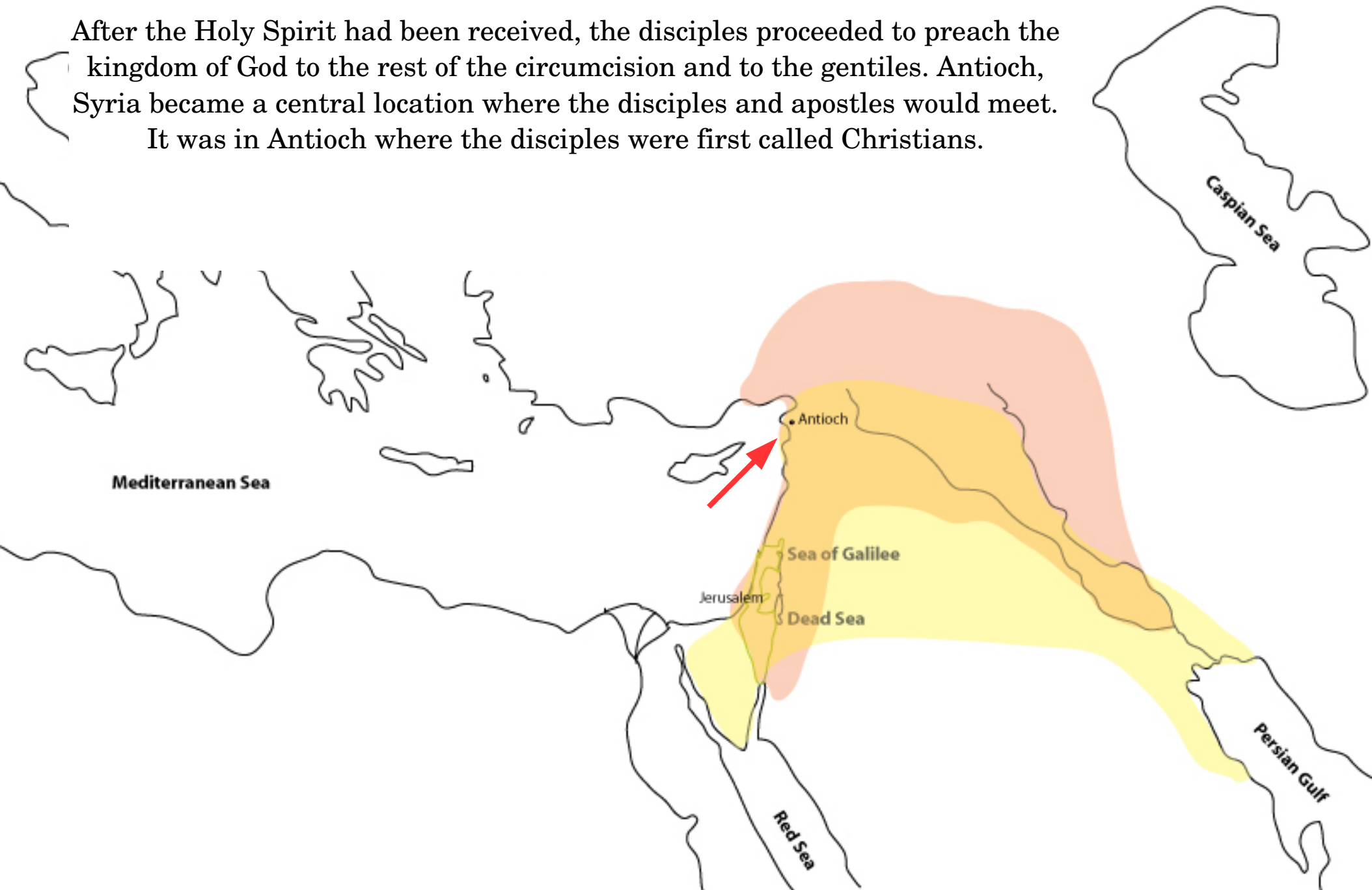

With the circumcision dispersed throughout the Assyrian and Babylonian empires, Jesus the Messiah was born in Bethlehem of Judaea. At about age thirty he began to preach the kingdom of God. At the end of his ministry he went to Jerusalem where he was betrayed and crucified. He became the perfect sacrifice to die in our place for our sins. Three days later he rose from the dead and showed himself to his disciples. He then returned to the Father and sent the Holy Spirit to indwell each believer.



After the Holy Spirit had been received, the disciples proceeded to preach the kingdom of God to the rest of the circumcision and to the gentiles. Antioch, Syria became a central location where the disciples and apostles would meet. It was in Antioch where the disciples were first called Christians.

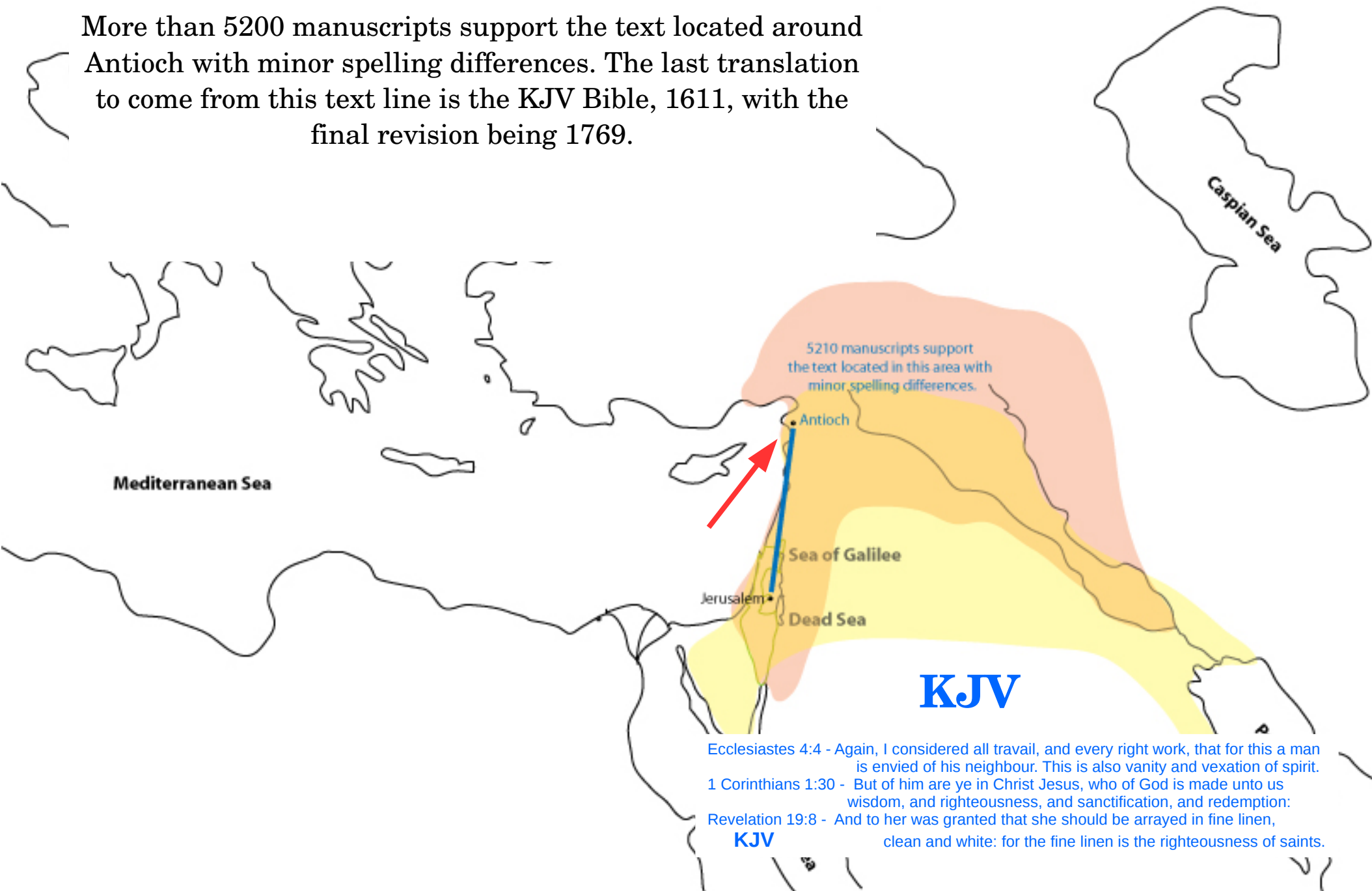




### Antioch Text Line

More than 5200 manuscripts support the text located around Antioch with minor spelling differences. The last translation to come from this text line is the KJV Bible, 1611, with the final revision being 1769.



**KJV**

Ecclesiastes 4:4 - Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this a man is envied of his neighbour. This is also vanity and vexation of spirit.

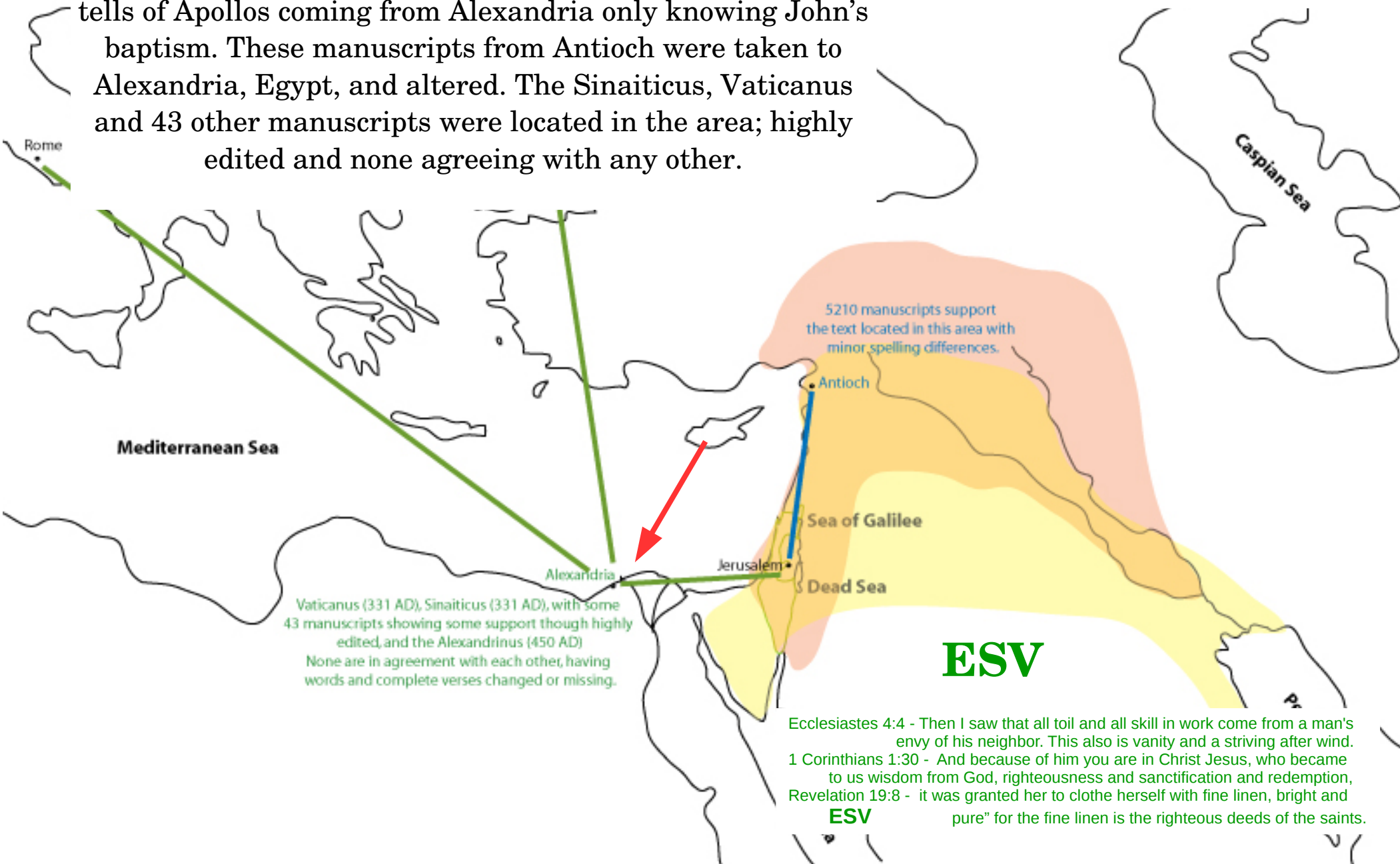
1 Corinthians 1:30 - But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

**KJV**

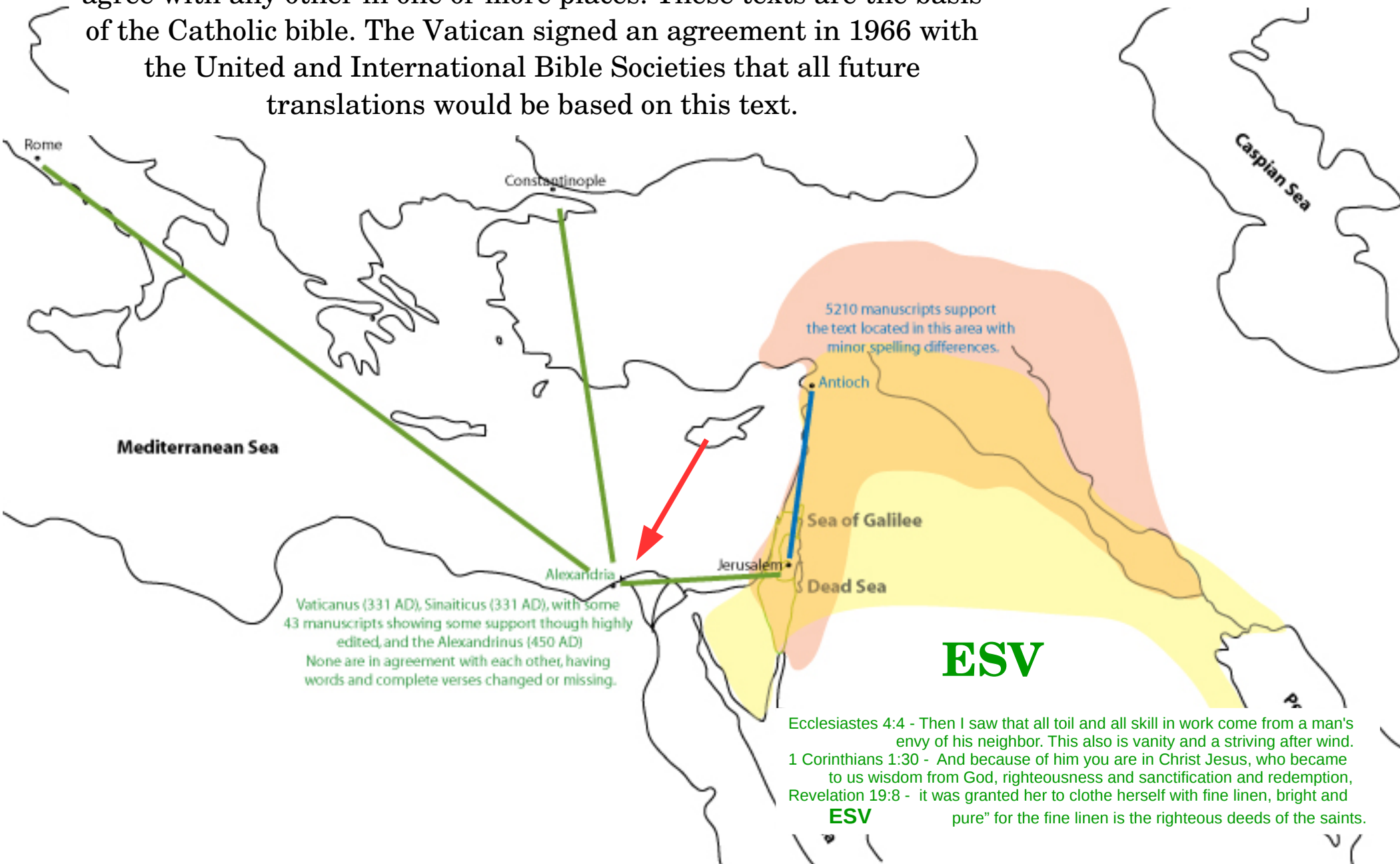
The Bible never records even one disciple or apostle ever even going to Alexandria. The book of Acts records scholars from Alexandria involved in the stoning of Stephen. It also tells of Apollos coming from Alexandria only knowing John's baptism. These manuscripts from Antioch were taken to Alexandria, Egypt, and altered. The Sinaiticus, Vaticanus and 43 other manuscripts were located in the area; highly edited and none agreeing with any other.

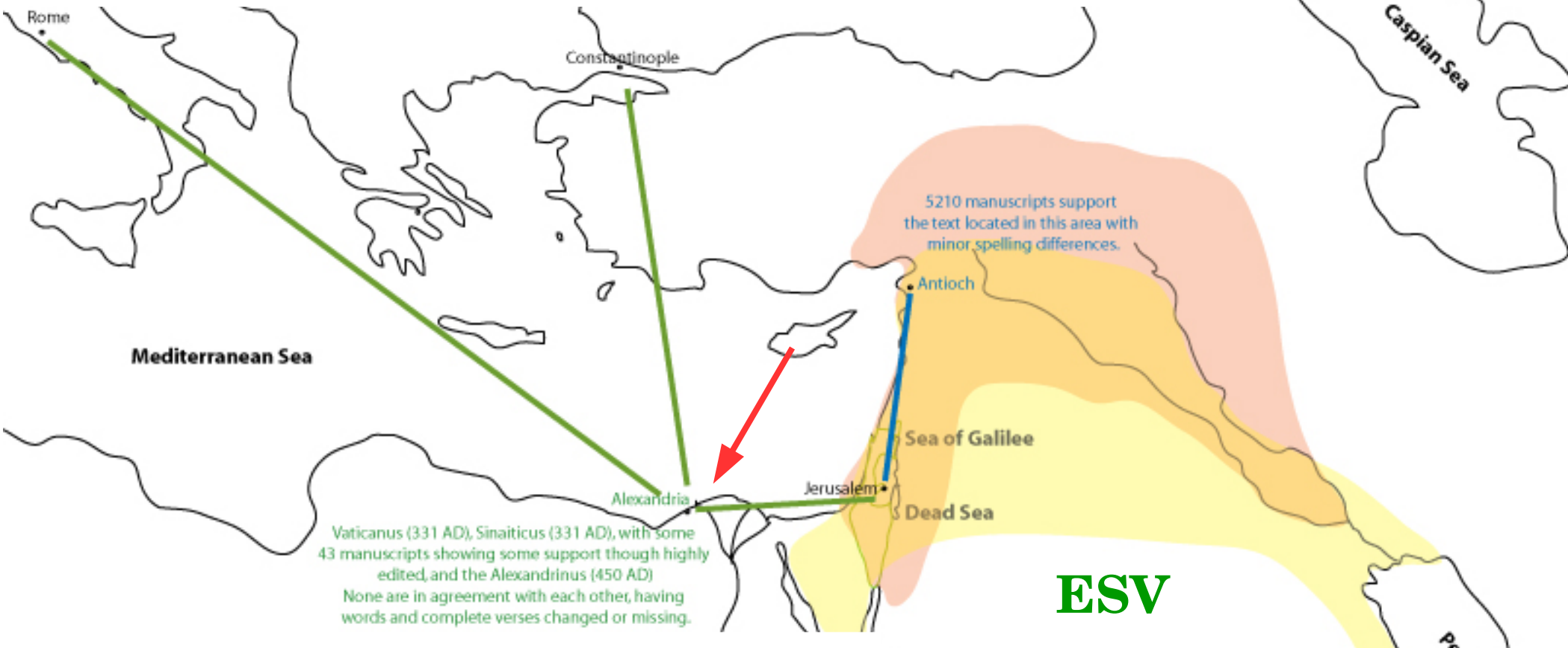
Within the translations from the Alexandrian text the truth can be found, but the trick is you first have to know the truth. Every translation made from these texts says the direct opposite of the Antioch text in one or more places. Also these translations do not agree with any other in one or more places. These texts are the basis of the Catholic bible. The Vatican signed an agreement in 1966 with the United and International Bible Societies that all future translations would be based on this text.

Peter and Paul both warned that the Word was being corrupted. In 2 Corinthians 11:3-4 Paul warns that as the serpent beguiled Eve, so our minds could be corrupted. He also warns that this new gospel is another Jesus, which includes another Spirit. In 2 Timothy 3:5 he says it is a form of godliness yet denying the power thereof. In verse 7 he implies that people studying these translations will be “Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth”.
