






Peter and Paul both warned that the Word was being corrupted. In 2 Corinthians 11:3-4 Paul warns that as the serpant beguiled Eve, so our minds could be corrupted. He also warns that this new gospel is another Jesus, which includes another Spirit. In 2 Timothy 3:5 he says it is a form of godliness yet denying the power thereof. In verse 7 he implies that people studying these translations will be "Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth".

Constantinople 5210 manuscripts support the text located in this area with minor, spelling differences.
